| 10 | c. One member who is a nurse licensed to practice nursing in Delaware who has experience in the |

SYNOPSIS

Lyme disease are appointed for an initial term of 3 years.".

This amendment makes the following changes to House Bill No. 425: (1)It provides the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the Pro Tempore of the Senate each an additional appointment to the Lyme Disease Oversight Board; and (2) Includes a licensed health care professional other than a nurse or physician who had been removed by House Bill No. 425 back on the Board.
