7	FURTHER AMEND House Bill No. 141 on line 82 by inserting after "check" the following: "no earlier than 90
8	days before the candidate filing deadline and".
9	FURTHER AMEND House Bill No. 141 on line 103 by inserting after "check" the following: "no earlier than 90
10	days before the candidate filing deadline and".

SYNOPSIS

This Amendment adds that the earliest an unaffiliated candidate, candidate nominated by a party, write-in candidate, and candidate for special elections to the General Assembly may request a criminal background check is 90 days before the candidate filing deadline. The Amendment also adds that the earliest a candidate in a primary election may request a criminal background check is the first date an individual may file as a candidate.
