## HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 13

RECOGNIZING MAY 10, 2017 AS "NATIONAL SCHOOL NURSE DAY".

1	WHEREAS, children are the future and, by investing in them today, we are ensuring our world for tomorrow; and
2	WHEREAS, families deserve to feel confident that their children will be cared for when they are at school; and
3	WHEREAS, all students have a right to have their health needs safely met while in the school setting; and
4	WHEREAS, children today face more complex and life-threatening health problems requiring care in school; and
5	WHEREAS, school nurses have served a critical role in improving public health and in ensuring student's
6	academic success for more than 100 years; and
7	WHEREAS, school nurses address the home and community factors, such as social determinants, that impact
8	students' health; and
9	WHEREAS, school nurses are professional nurses that advance the well-being, academic success, and life-long
10	achievements of all students by serving on the frontlines and providing a critical safety net for our nation's most fragile
11	children; and
12	WHEREAS, school nurses act as a liaison to the school community, families, and healthcare providers on behalf
13	of children's health by promoting wellness and improving health outcomes for our nation's children; and
14	WHEREAS, school nurses support the health and educational success of children and youth by providing access to
15	care when children's cognitive development is at its peak; and
16	WHEREAS, school nurses are members of school-based teams for programs such as school health services,
17	Section 504 and Individualized Education Plans ("IEP"), and disaster and emergency planning that address the school
18	population; and
19	WHEREAS, during the 2015-2016 school year, 100% of students attending Delaware public schools had access to
20	a full-time school nurse and 97.5% of students attending a Delaware non-public school had access to a school nurse; and
21	WHEREAS, during the 2015-2016 school year, Delaware public school nurses provided vision screening to
22	64,551 students in grades Pre-K through grade 12 and, of those screened, 6628, over 10%, were referred for further
