HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 149th GENERAL ASSEMBLY

HOUSE BILL NO. 260

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 29 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO GRANT-IN-AID.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

- 1 Section 1. Amend Chapter 63, Title 29 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and 2 insertions as shown by underline as follows: 3 § 6341A Grant-In-Aid Committee. 4 (a) There shall be a Grant-In-Aid Committee. The purpose of the Committee shall be to review requests for grant-5 in-aid and develop the grant-in-aid appropriations bill. 6 (b) The Grant-In-Aid Committee is composed of 3 members of the Senate appointed by the President Pro Tempore 7 and 3 members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House. Not more than 2 Senate appointees, 8 nor 2 House appointees, may belong to the same political party. The Chairperson and Vice Chairperson of the Committee 9 alternate each year between a Representative appointed by the Speaker of the House and a Senator appointed by the 10 President Pro Tem of the Senate. During odd-numbered years, a Senator serves as Chairperson and a Representative serves 11 as Vice Chairperson; during even-numbered years, a Representative serves as Chairperson and a Senator serves as Vice 12 Chairperson. 13 (c) The Grant-In-Aid Committee shall review the performance and efficacy of grant-in-aid recipients. 14 Section 2. The Chairperson, the Vice Chairperson, and Members of the Grant-In-Aid Committee shall be 15 compensated at the rate of the Joint Legislative Oversight and Sunset Committee for their service on the Committee.
 - Section 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2018.

SYNOPSIS

This bill creates the Grant-In-Aid Committee. The Committee is a joint committee of the Senate and House of Representatives. The purpose of the Committee is to review requests for grant-in-aid and to develop the grant-in-aid appropriations bill.
