#### HOUSE BILL NO. 263

# AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 18 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO UNFAIR PRACTICES IN THE INSURANCE BUSINESS

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

1 Section 1. Amend § 2304, Title 18 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and 2 insertions as shown by underline as follows: 3 § 2304. Unfair methods of competition and unfair or deceptive acts or practices defined. 4 The following are hereby defined as unfair methods of competition and unfair or deceptive acts or practices in the 5 business of insurance: 6 (16) Unfair claim settlement practices. — No person shall commit or perform with such frequency as to 7 indicate a general business practice any of the following: 8 h. Attempting to settle a claim for less than the amount to which a reasonable person would have believed 9 that person's own self was entitled by reference to written or printed advertising material accompanying or made 10 part of an application, an amount which was obtained by reference to a common, verifiable compilation of valuation data, or by reference to the retail value for a substantially similar motor vehicle from a nationally 11 12 recognized valuation database; Section 2. This Act takes effect 90 days after its enactment into law. 13

## **SYNOPSIS**

This Act prohibits insurance companies from frequently attempting to settle claims with their insureds for less than an amount a reasonable person would believe to be fair based on a common, verifiable compilation of valuation data, such as the NADA guides.
