HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 63

EXTENDING THE REPORTING DATE OF THE DELAWARE ANTI-DUMPING AND ANTI-LITTERING
SOLUTIONS TASK FORCE.

1 WHEREAS, the Delaware Anti-Dumping and Anti-Littering Solutions Task Force was established under House
2 Concurrent Resolution No. 9 of the 149th General Assembly to study litter and illegal dumping and to make findings and
3 recommendations based on the study; and

4 WHEREAS, the Task Force was directed to submit its findings and recommendations report to all members of the
5 General Assembly and Governor John Carney no later than April 1, 2018; and

6 WHEREAS, the Task Force has worked diligently on its study, but is not yet prepared to submit its report; and

7 WHEREAS, the members of the Task Force believe that they will be able to submit the report by September 30,
8 2018.

9 NOW, THEREFORE:

10 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 149th General Assembly of the State of Delaware, the
11 Senate concurring therein, that the date by which the findings and recommendations report of the Delaware Anti-Dumping
12 and Anti-Littering Solutions Task Force is due be extended to September 30, 2018.
