HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 63

EXTENDING THE REPORTING DATE OF THE DELAWARE ANTI-DUMPING AND ANTI-LITTERING SOLUTIONS TASK FORCE.

1 WHEREAS, the Delaware Anti-Dumping and Anti-Littering Solutions Task Force was established under House Concurrent Resolution No. 9 of the 149th General Assembly to study litter and illegal dumping and to make findings and 2 3 recommendations based on the study; and 4 WHEREAS, the Task Force was directed to submit its findings and recommendations report to all members of the 5 General Assembly and Governor John Carney no later than April 1, 2018; and 6 WHEREAS, the Task Force has worked diligently on its study, but is not yet prepared to submit its report; and 7 WHEREAS, the members of the Task Force believe that they will be able to submit the report by September 30, 8 2018. 9 NOW, THEREFORE: 10 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 149th General Assembly of the State of Delaware, the

- 11 Senate concurring therein, that the date by which the findings and recommendations report of the Delaware Anti-Dumping
- 12 and Anti-Littering Solutions Task Force is due be extended to September 30, 2018.
