SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 29

WHEREAS, there are over 3 million licensed nurses in the United States and over 10,000 in the state of Delaware

3	WHEREAS, registered nurses and licensed practical nurses provide unique medical care for numerous American
4	citizens across an array of settings; and
5	WHEREAS, the American Nurses Association (ANA), which acts to represent the interests of registered nurses
6	and licensed practical nurses in the United States, is at the forefront of improving the quality of health care for all citizens;
7	and
8	WHEREAS, a renewed emphasis on primary and preventative health care will require better utilization of all our
9	country's registered nursing and licensed practical nursing resources; and
10	WHEREAS, professional nursing is an indispensable component in the safety and quality of care offered to
11	hospitalized patients; and
12	WHEREAS, the demand for registered nurses and licensed practical nurses is greater now than ever before due to
13	the aging of the American population, the continuing expansion of life-sustaining technologies, and the exponential growth
14	of home health care services; and
15	WHEREAS, more qualified register nurses and licensed practical nurses will be needed in the future to meet the
16	continually growing complex needs of health care consumers in Delaware and across the country; and
17	WHEREAS, the cost-effective, safe, and quality health care services provided by registered nurses and licensed
18	practical nurses will be an increasingly important component of the United States health care delivery system in the future;

20	WHEREAS, beginning under the Reagan administration, the week beginning on May 6th and ending on May 12th,
21	Florence Nightingale's birthday, is denoted annually as National Nurses Week; and
22	WHEREAS, the theme for this year's National Nurses Week is "A Voice to Lead—Health for All."
