## HOUSE BILL NO. 210

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 16 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO AUTHORIZING A PILOT PROGRAM TO ISSUE GRANTS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF RESIDENTIAL DRINKING WATER PURIFICATION SYSTEMS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

- Section 1. Add a new Section to Title 16 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and insertions as shown by underline as follows:

  § 3001N. Establishment of Residential Drinking Water Purification System Grant Program
- (a) The Department of Health and Social Services is authorized to establish a pilot program to issue grants for the installation of drinking water purification systems in residential homes located in Delaware where the owner's income is less than 200% of the poverty level in Delaware and the home is not served by a central water system. The geographical
- The total amount of grants authorized for the pilot program shall not exceed \$49,000 per year and the funds will come from the Non-Federal Administrative Allowance of the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund.
- Section 2. This act shall sunset 2 years after its effective date.

## **SYNOPSIS**

This bill establishes a 2 year residential drinking water purification system pilot grant program to be administered through the Department of Health and Social Services with funding from the Non-Federal Administrative Allowance of the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund.
