<b>DESCRIPTION:</b>	<b>AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 16 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO THE EMERGENCY PLANNING AND COMMUNITY RIGHT TO KNOW ACT.</b>

In accordance with 29 Del. C. §913, the following information is provided relating to fees.

Description of the Legislation

This Act will provide for an increase in fees collected with annual hazardous chemical inventory reports submitted by facilities.

Affected Entities

There are 1,335 facilities that currently report regulated substances and are paying fees.

Fiscal Impact Estimate

The State Emergency Response Commission estimates that the increase in fees will result in \$120,860 of additional revenue.

Intended Use of Revenue

The fees shall be appropriated to the State Emergency Response Commission through the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control primarily for the purpose of funding the local emergency planning committees, data collection and management activities.
