HOUSE AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO HOUSE SUBSTITUTE NO. 1 FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 143

1 AMEND House Substitute No. 1 for House Bill No. 143 at lines 67 thru 69 by striking "<u>An individual provided an</u>

2 initial license prior to [the effective date of this Act] shall not be subject to the requirement of a passing score on an

3 approved performance assessment for movement to a continuing license."

4 FURTHER AMEND House Substitute No. 1 for House Bill No. 143 by inserting on line 263 after the period, the

5 following: "An individual issued an initial license prior to the enactment date shall not be subject to the requirement of a

6 passing score on an approved performance assessment or a passing score on a general knowledge exam."

SYNOPSIS

This amendment clarifies implementation of this Act to ensure those educators already on an initial license with multiple years to pass a general knowledge exam, such as School Nurses and Skilled and Technical Science Instructors, are no longer obligated to meet the requirement of passing a general knowledge exam and also clarifies that those educators currently on an initial license are not required to pass an approved performance assessment for movement to a continuing license.
