

149th GENERAL ASSEMBLY FISCAL NOTE

BILL: SENATE BILL NO. 10

AS AMENDED BY: SA 3

SPONSOR: Senator Marshall

DESCRIPTION: AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 19 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO

MINIMUM WAGE.

Assumptions:

1. Effective upon signature of the Governor.

- 2. This Amended Bill increases the minimum wage, as follows:
 - from \$8.25 per hour to \$8.75 per hour, effective October 1, 2018;
 - from \$8.75 per hour to \$9.25 per hour, effective October 1, 2019.
- 3. This Amended Bill impacts State casual/seasonal positions making less than the hourly minimum wage as of each annual effective date. State full-time employees are not compensated less than the proposed minimum wage. A total of 188 casual/seasonal employees are estimated to be impacted by this Bill.
- 4. Other Employee Costs are included in the projections at 9.32%.
- 5. This Bill impacts positions compensated through the State's General Fund (GF) and Appropriated Special Funds (ASF). Transportation Trust Fund (TTF) positions are compensated above the proposed minimum wage.
- 6. Assumes no other inflationary increases during FY 2019 through FY 2021. FY 2021 annualizes FY 2020 costs.
