AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 18 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO INSURANCE
DISCRIMINATION BASED ON PRE-EXPOSURE PROPHYLAXIS MEDICATION TO PREVENT HIV
INFECTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

Section 1. Amend Chapter 23, Title 18 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and insertions as shown by underline as follows:

§ 2320. Discrimination prohibited; pre-exposure prophylaxis medication to prevent HIV infection.

A person engaged in the business of life, disability, or long-term care insurance may not do any of the following solely because an individual has been prescribed pre-exposure prophylaxis medication to prevent HIV infection:

- (1) Deny, refuse to issue, refuse to renew, refuse to reissue, cancel, or otherwise terminate an insurance policy or restrict coverage.
- (2) Add any surcharge or rating factor to a premium of an insurance policy.
- (3) Otherwise discriminate in the offering, issuance, cancellation, amount of coverage, price, payment of claims, or any other condition of an insurance policy without additional actuarial justification.
