### **OMB Fiscal Year 2024 Bond Bill Requests**

#### **Building Maintenance Requests**

- \$8 million MCI
- \$1.5 million Environmental Compliance
- \$150,000 Architectural Barrier Removal
- \$5 million Roof Replacements
- \$8 million Deferred Maintenance

#### **Market Pressure Project Requests**

- \$60 million market pressure for statewide projects
- \$30 million Delaware Hospital for the Chronically III (\$50 million ARPA)
- \$5.57 million DNREC Lab (\$30 million ARPA)
- \$5 million OMB Food Distribution Warehouse (\$10 million ARPA)
- \$3.2 million DSCYF Wharton Hall

### \$25 M: ERP Cloud Migration

 This upgrade will create system efficiencies, reduce downtime, and most importantly - will address the end-of-life cycle for the on-premise application.

#### \$2 M: Statewide Space Study

 Study will help agencies identify existing space gaps in order to reduce their leased footprint and better use their state allocated space

#### \$8 M: Land &Building Acquisitions

Provides DFM with flexibility in purchasing property if it makes financial sense
