

## Joint Committee on Capital Improvements

The Fiscal Year 2022 Bond and Capital Improvements Act allocates \$70,000,000 for the Community Reinvestment/Redevelopment Fund to be used for community redevelopment, revitalization and investment in capital projects which will improve the economic, culture, historical, and recreational health of Delaware communities.
