## Roof Replacement and Cupola Rehabilitation Project Information

The Division of Facilities Management is overseeing a project to replace the roof on Legislative Hall and rehabilitate Legislative Hall's cupola. This project is underway and is expected to be completed in December 2023.

While the General Assembly anticipates that impacts to its operations should be minimal, visitors to Legislative Hall should be aware of the following:

- Parking in the parking lot next to the Del-One Credit Union will be limited as the rear of the
  parking lot is being used by the project contractor as a staging area for materials for the project.
  As a result, parking in the parking lot next to the Del-One Credit Union will be more limited than
  usual. Therefore, visitors should arrive early to ensure there is sufficient time to find
  parking. Parking is available in the parking lot behind the Tatnall building (across the street from
  the Del-One Credit Union) or in the parking lot at the Public Archives building.
- This project will produce noise that will impact both the exterior and the interior of Legislative Hall. Please pardon the noise as the project contractor works diligently to complete the project.
- Lighting of the cupola in honor of requested events will not be possible during most of the project, beginning January 16, 2023.
- Events may not be held on the east side steps at Legislative Hall during most of this project, beginning January 9, 2023. - Scaffolding will be up around Legislative Hall for much of the project. This is to ensure the safety
  of legislators, staff, and the public who come to Legislative Hall and will enable all entrances to
  Legislative Hall to remain open during the project.
