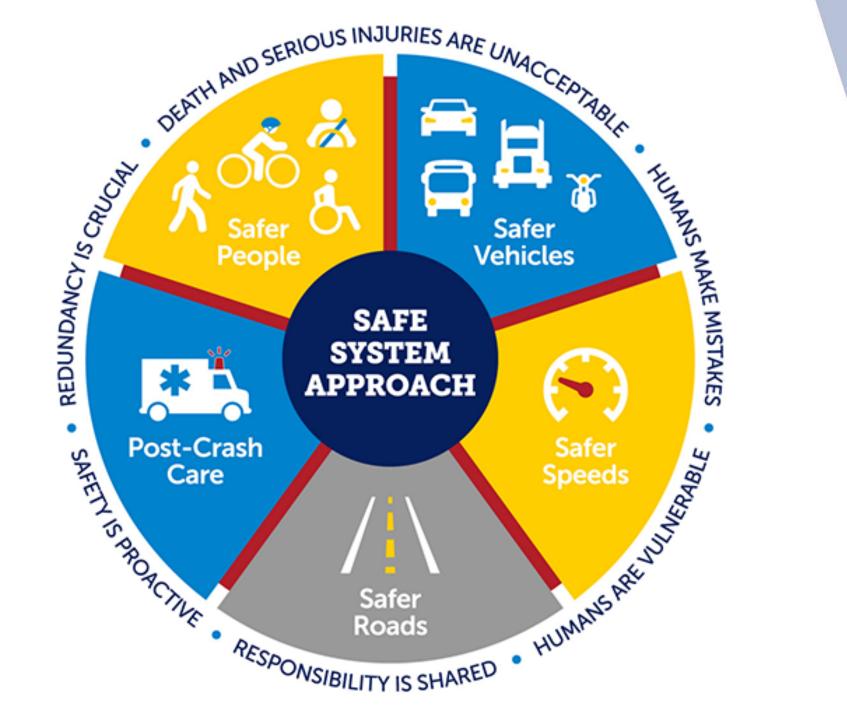

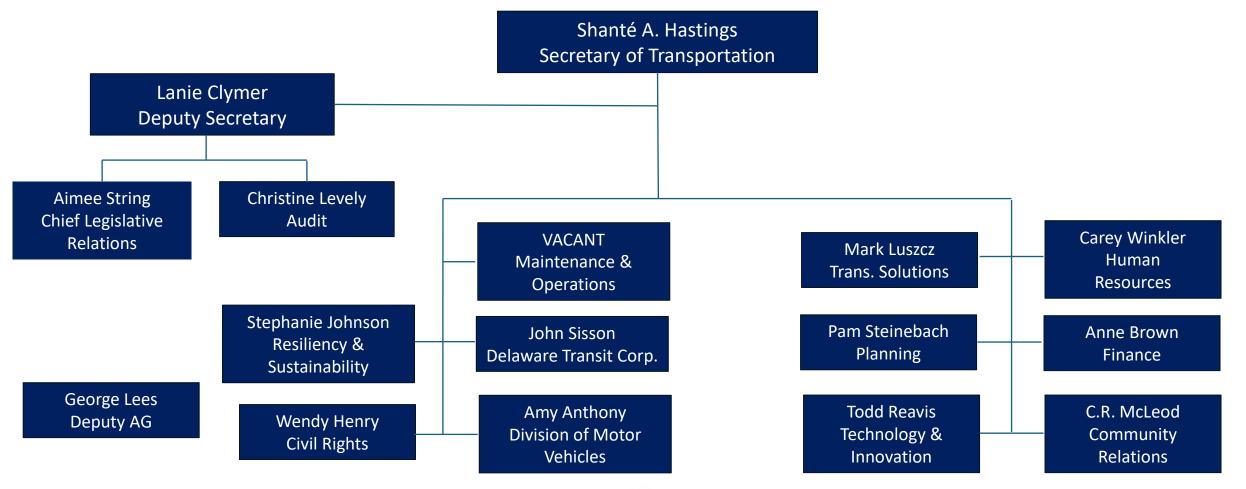

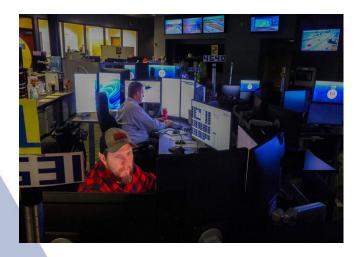

## Vacancy Rates & Recruitment Efforts

Overall Vacancy Rate: 12%

- Equipment Operators: 15% vacancy (53 positions vacant)
- Mechanics: 14% vacancy (10 positions vacant)
- Engineering Positions: 17% vacancy (32 positions vacant)
- DMV Frontline: 8% vacancy (27 positions vacant)
- Bus Drivers: 6% vacancy (40 positions vacant)

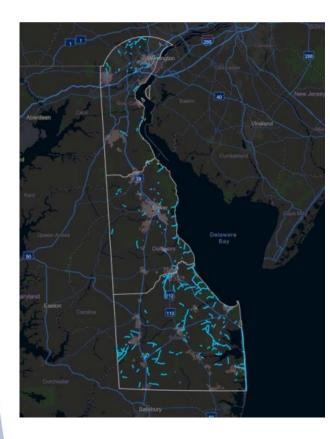

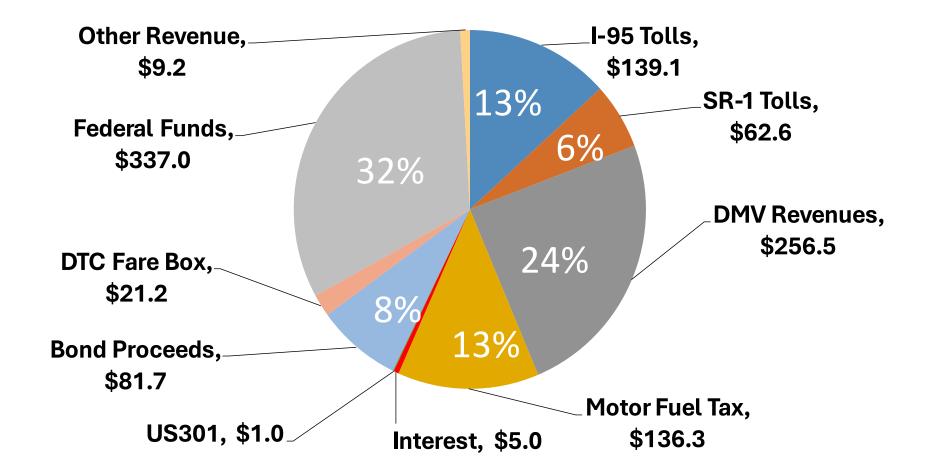

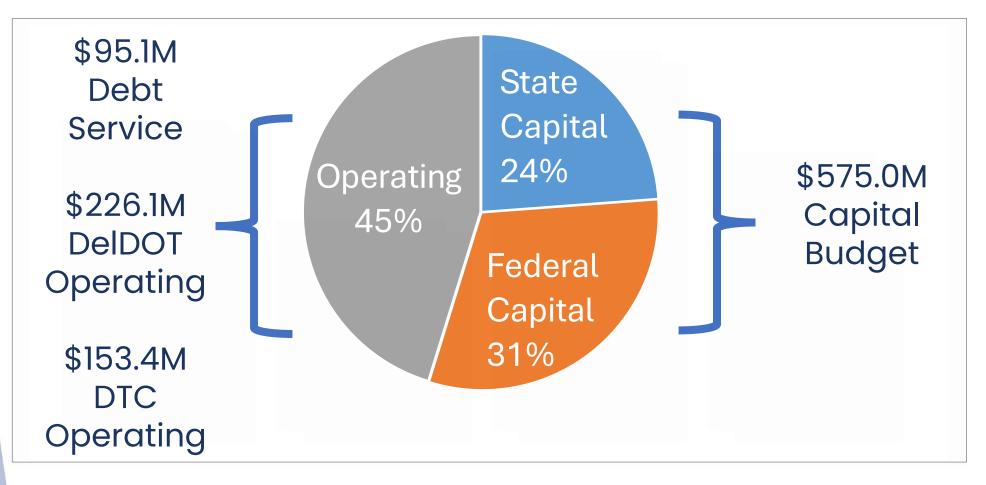


#### FY26 - Sources of Funds - \$1,049.6M (in millions)





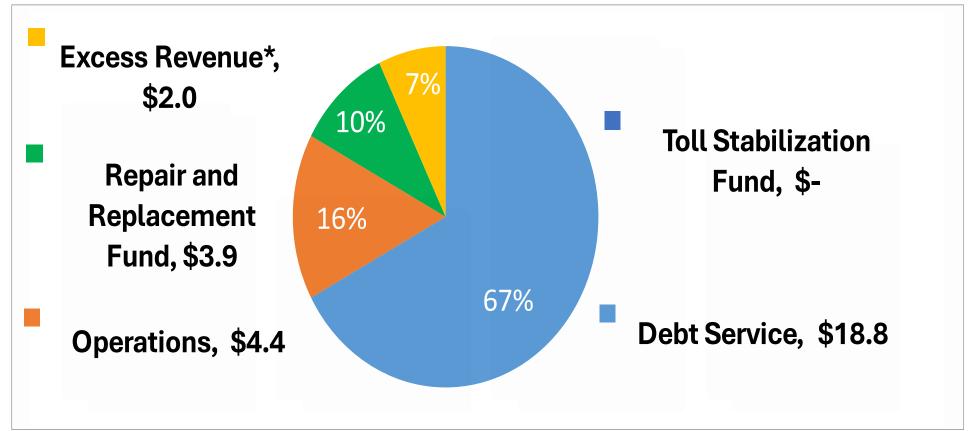
#### FY26 – DelDOT Budget- \$1,049.6M (in millions)

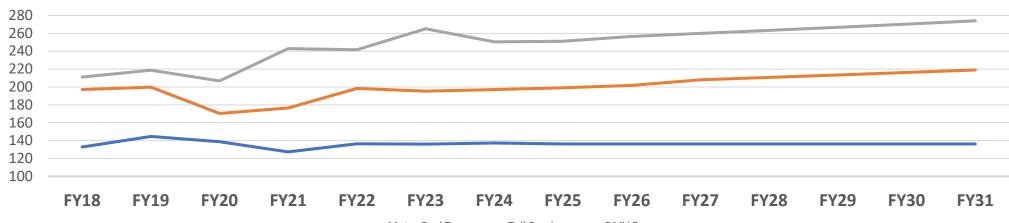

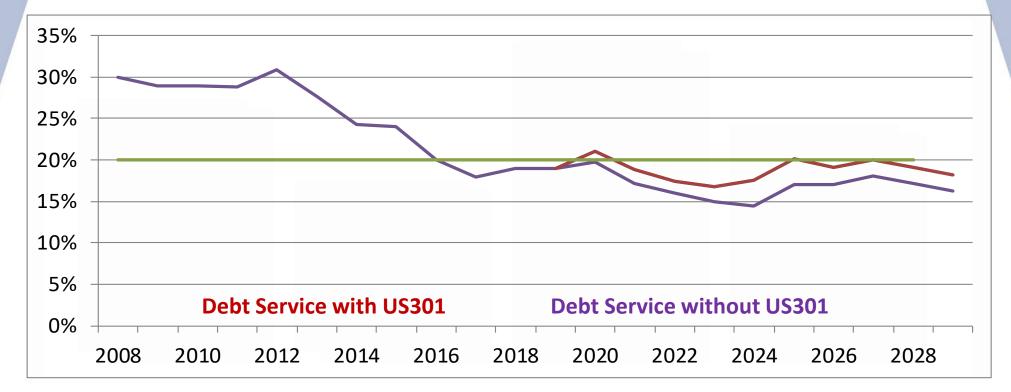

## Debt Service as a % of Revenue

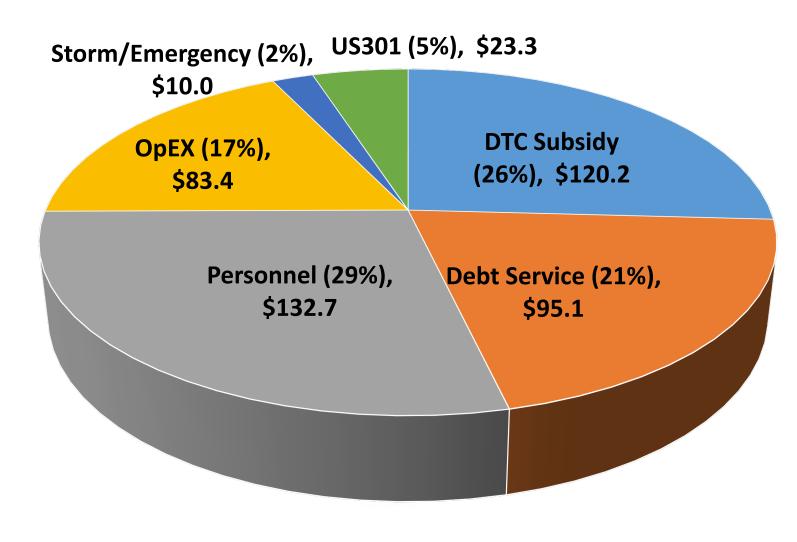
