

- Building a STEM and engineering workforce in Delaware




UD-Bayhealth Nursing Program




First State Promise

- Supports more than one-third of our full-time Delaware students
- Eligibility: Students whose family income is \$75,000 or less
- Coverage: Total tuition costs
- Additional needs-based aid:
 Support for room, board and fees
- Incomes above \$75,000: Partial aid

- Blue economy aquaculture, energy, coastal tourism










FSP, SEED & Associate Programs

Ocean & Environment provide Delaware with essential resources for residents, farmers, businesses and community leaders:


