ENACTMENT RATE[§] OF BILLS INTRODUCED DURING THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 151ST GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Out of the 275 bills introduced by the House of Representatives during the 1st session, 156 have been enacted into law. This gives an enactment rate of 57%.

Out of the 213 bills introduced by the Senate during the 1st session, 138 have been enacted into law. This gives an enactment rate of 65%.

VETOES OF BILLS INTRODUCED DURING THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 151ST GENERAL ASSEMBLY

The Governor did not veto any legislation introduced during the 1st session.

* General Assemblies begin the day after a general election and end the next general election. We have defined the 1st session as ending on the day the State would have a general election if held in an odd year. For this data, the “1st session” would be 11/3/2020 to 11/2/2021. This includes any legislation introduced in special or extraordinary sessions in this period.

† In this report, each substitute to a bill counts as its own bill. For example, 1 bill with 1 substitute for that bill counts as 2 bills.

‡ In this report, an amendment to an amendment counts as its own piece of legislation. For example, House Amendment 1 to a bill and an amendment to House Amendment 1 would count as 2 amendments.
