ENACTMENT RATE[§] OF BILLS INTRODUCED DURING THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 152ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Out of the 253 bills introduced by the House of Representatives during the 2nd session, 143 have been enacted into law. This gives an enactment rate of 57%.

Out of the 185 bills introduced by the Senate during the 2nd session, 113 have been enacted into law. This gives an enactment rate of 61%.

VETOES OF BILLS INTRODUCED DURING THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 152ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY

The Governor vetoed 1 bill** introduced by the House of Representatives during the 2nd session. This veto was overridden by the General Assembly and the bill was enacted into law.

The Governor did not veto any legislation introduced by the Senate during the 2nd session.

* General Assemblies begin the day after a general election and end the next general election. We have defined the 2nd session as beginning the day after the State would have a general election if held in an odd year. For this data, the "2nd session" would be 11/8/2023 to 11/5/2024. This includes any legislation introduced in special or extraordinary sessions in this period.

† In this report, each substitute to a bill counts as its own bill. For example, 1 bill with 1 substitute for that bill counts as 2 bills.

‡ In this report, an amendment to an amendment counts as its own piece of legislation. For example, House Amendment 1 to a bill and an amendment to House Amendment 1 would count as 2 amendments.

** The Governor vetoed House Bill 282.
