## ENACTMENT RATE§ IN 1<sup>ST</sup> SESSION OF BILLS INTRODUCED DURING THE 1<sup>ST</sup> SESSION OF THE 152<sup>ND</sup> GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Out of the 279 bills introduced by the House of Representatives during the 1<sup>st</sup> session, 120 have been enacted into law during the 1<sup>st</sup> session. This gives an enactment rate of 43%.

Out of the 204 bills introduced by the Senate during the 1<sup>st</sup> session, 120 have been enacted into law during the 1<sup>st</sup> session. This gives an enactment rate of 59%.

## VETOES IN 1<sup>ST</sup> SESSION OF BILLS INTRODUCED DURING THE 1<sup>ST</sup> SESSION OF THE 152<sup>ND</sup> GENERAL ASSEMBLY

During the 1<sup>st</sup> session, the Governor did not veto any legislation introduced during the 1<sup>st</sup> session.

<sup>\*</sup> General Assemblies begin the day after a general election and end the next general election. We have defined the 1st session as ending on the day the State would have a general election if held in an odd year. For this data, the "1st session" would be 11/9/2022 to 11/7/2023. This includes any legislation introduced in special or extraordinary sessions in this period.

<sup>†</sup> In this report, each substitute to a bill counts as its own bill. For example, 1 bill with 1 substitute for that bill counts as 2 bills.

<sup>‡</sup> In this report, an amendment to an amendment counts as its own piece of legislation. For example, House Amendment 1 to a bill and an amendment to House Amendment 1 would count as 2 amendments.
