HOUSE BILL NO. 235

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 4 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

1 Section 1. Amend § 709, Title 4 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and
2 insertions as shown by underline as follows:

3 § 709. Prohibition of sales and delivery at certain times [Effective until meeting the contingency in 82 Del. Laws,
4 c. 193, § 5].

5 (c) No holder of a license for the sale of alcoholic liquor for on-premises consumption shall sell the same between
6 the hours of 1:00 a.m. and ~~9:00~~ 8:00 a.m. The closing hour may be made earlier in any municipality by ordinance of the
7 municipal corporation. The sale of alcoholic liquors by a licensee for consumption on the premises where sold shall be
8 permitted on every day of the year; provided, that no licensee shall be required to be open to sell alcoholic liquors on
9 Sundays, Thanksgiving, Easter or Christmas.

10 § 709. Prohibition of sales and delivery at certain times [Effective upon meeting the contingency in 82 Del. Laws,
11 c. 193, § 5].

12 (c) No holder of a license for the sale of alcoholic liquor for on-premises consumption shall sell the same between
13 the hours of 1:00 a.m. and ~~9:00~~ 8:00 a.m. The closing hour may be made earlier in any municipality by ordinance of the
14 municipal corporation. The sale of alcoholic liquors by a licensee for consumption on the premises where sold shall be
15 permitted on every day of the year; provided, that no licensee shall be required to be open to sell alcoholic liquors on
16 Sundays, Thanksgiving, Easter or Christmas.

SYNOPSIS

This bill changes the time a holder of a license for the sale of alcoholic liquor for on-premises consumption may sell alcohol from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.
