HOUSE AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO HOUSE BILL NO. 291

AMEND House Bill No. 291 on Line 11 by inserting after "reporting period." the following:

"A person's primary employer and job title must be kept of record by the Department, but this information is not a

public record under Chapter 100 of Title 29.".

FURTHER AMEND House Bill No. 291 on Line 31 by deleting "pay" and inserting in lieu thereof "return".

FURTHER AMEND House Bill No. 291 on Lines 31 and 32 by deleting "State Treasurer for deposit in the

General Fund." and inserting in lieu thereof "donor.".

SYNOPSIS

This Amendment requires the Department of Elections to keep a record of donors' employers and their job title but this information will not be considered a public record under FOIA. This Amendment also requires a reporting party who has knowingly accepted an unlawful contribution to return it to the donor rather than pay it to the State Treasurer for deposit in the General Fund.
