HOUSE BILL NO. 360

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 1 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO STATE HOLIDAYS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

1 Section 1. Amend § 501, Title 1 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and  
2 insertions as shown by underline as follows and redesignating accordingly:

3 § 501. Designation

4 (a) The following days shall be legal holidays in this State:

5 (1) January 1, known as New Year's Day.

6 (2) The third Monday in January, known as Martin Luther King, Jr. Day.

7 (3) Good Friday.

8 (4) Eid ul-Fitr.

9 (5) Eid ul-Adha.

10 ~~(4)~~ (6) June 19, known as Juneteenth.

11 ~~(5)~~ (7) July 4, known as Independence Day.

12 ~~(6)~~ (8) The first Monday in September, known as Labor Day.

13 ~~(7)~~ (9) November 11, known as Veterans Day.

14 ~~(8)~~ (10) The fourth Thursday in November, known as Thanksgiving Day.

15 ~~(9)~~ (11) The Friday following Thanksgiving Day.

16 ~~(10)~~ (12) December 25, known as Christmas.

17 ~~(11)~~ (13) Saturdays.

18 ~~(12)~~ (14) The day of the General Election as it biennially occurs; and

19 ~~(13)~~ (15) In Sussex County, Return Day, the second day after the General Election, after 12:00 Noon.

20 (b) If any of the legal holidays fall on Sunday, the Monday following shall be a legal holiday. If any of the legal  
21 holidays other than Saturday fall on Saturday, the Friday preceding shall be a legal holiday.

SYNOPSIS

This Act adds Eid ul-Fitr and Eid ul-Adha to the list of state holidays.
