HOUSE BILL NO. 386

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 25 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO RENTAL AGREEMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

- Section 1. Amend Chapter 53, Title 25 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and insertions as shown by underline as follows:

 § 5301. Landlord obligation; rental agreement.

 (a) A rental agreement shall not provide that a tenant:

 (1) Agrees to waive or forego rights or remedies under this Code; Code.

 (2) Authorizes any person to confess judgment on a claim arising out of the rental agreement; agreement.

 (3) Agrees to the exculpation or limitation of any liability of the landlord arising under law or to indemnify
 - (4) Must declaw a cat as a condition of a rental agreement.

the landlord for that liability or the costs connected therewith.

SYNOPSIS

This Act prohibits a landlord from requiring a tenant declaw a cat as a condition for entering into or renewing a rental agreement. This Act also makes technical corrections to conform existing law to the standards of the Delaware Legislative Drafting Manual.
