HOUSE BILL NO. 408

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 21 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO INDICATING THE HOLDER IS A VETERAN ON DRIVER LICENSES AND NONDRIVER IDENTIFICATION CARDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE (Three-fifths of all members elected to each house thereof concurring therein):

1 Section 1. Amend §2718, Title 21 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and

- 2 insertions as shown by underline as follows:
- 3 § 2718. Information on licenses.
- 4 (g) The Division of Motor Vehicles shall upon submission of satisfactory proof, designate on a driver license that
- 5 the holder is a veteran of the United States Armed Forces or of the National Guard.
- 6 (1) An applicant qualifies to have designation that the holder is a veteran added to their driver license if the
- 7 applicant served in the United States Armed Forces, including a reserve component of the National Guard, and was
- 8 <u>discharged or released from service under conditions other than dishonorable:</u>
- 9 (2) Satisfactory proof that the applicant is a veteran includes any of the following:
- 10 <u>a. Form DD-214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty.</u>
- 11 b. Form DD-256, Discharge Certificate that states "General Under Honorable Conditions".
- 12 c. Form NGB-22 Report of Separation and Record of Service, Departments of the Army and the Airforce,
- 13 <u>National Guard Bureau.</u>
- 14 <u>d. Valid Military ID Card including any of the following:</u>
- 15 <u>1. White Common Access Card.</u>
- 16 <u>2. Department of Defense Blue ID.</u>
- 17 <u>3. Department of Defense Red ID.</u>
- 18 e. A valid driver license issued by a state other than Delaware with designation that the holder is a
- 19 veteran.

21 renewal, or duplicate of a license, no fee in addition to the standard application or renewal fee may be charged for 22 adding designation that the holder is a veteran. 23 (4) When the licensee desires to add designation that the holder is a veteran before license renewal, a fee of 24 \$10 may be assessed for such change. 25 (5) The Division shall coordinate with the Delaware Office of Veterans Services to establish a method of authenticating unclear military documentation. 26 27 Section 2. Amend § 3104. Contents of identification cards. 28 (c) The Division of Motor Vehicles shall upon submission of satisfactory proof, provide that a person making 29 application for an identification card designation that the holder is a veteran on the identification card. 30 (1) An applicant qualifies to have designation that the holder is a veteran added to their identification card if 31 the applicant served in the United States Armed Forces, including a reserve component of the National Guard, and was 32 discharged or released from service under conditions other than dishonorable: 33 (2) Satisfactory proof of that the applicant is a veteran includes any of the following: 34 a. Form DD-214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty. 35 b. Form DD-256, Discharge Certificate that states "General Under Honorable Conditions".

(3) When the licensee desires to add designation that the holder is a veteran as part of an initial application,

- 38 <u>d. Valid Military ID Card including any of the following:</u>

- 42 e. A valid identification card issued by a state other than Delaware with designation that the holder is a
- 43 <u>veteran.</u>
- 44 (3) When and applicant for or holder of an identification card desires to add designation that the holder is a
- 45 veteran as part of an initial application, renewal, or duplicate of an identification card, no fee in addition to the standard
- 46 <u>application or renewal fee may be charged for adding designation that the holder is a veteran.</u>
- 47 (4) When the holder of an identification card desires to add designation that the holder is a veteran under
 48 before identification card renewal, a fee of \$10 may be assessed for such change.

SYNOPSIS

This Act would add designation that the holder is a veteran to the Delaware Driver License or Identification Card upon request. Adding designation that the holder is a veteran to a Driver License or Identification Card would eliminate the need for a veteran to carry a separate card or official discharge forms in order to prove their service.
