## SENATE BILL NO. 289

# AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 11 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO SEXUAL EXTORTION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

1	Section 1. Amend Chapter 5, Title 11 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and
2	insertions as shown by underline as follows:
3	§ 774. Sexual extortion; class E felony.
4	A person is guilty of sexual extortion when the person intentionally compels or induces another person to engage
5	in any sexual act involving contact, penetration or intercourse with the person or another or others, or to produce a visual
6	depiction of the person or another who is nude, or who is engaging in sexual conduct, with the person or another or others
7	by means of instilling in the victim a fear that, if such sexual act or production is not performed, the defendant or another
8	will:
9	(1) Cause physical injury to anyone;
10	(2) Cause damage to property;
11	(3) Engage in other conduct constituting a crime;
12	(4) Accuse anyone of a crime or cause criminal charges to be instituted against anyone;
13	(5) Expose a secret or publicize an asserted fact, whether true or false, intending to subject anyone to
14	hatred, contempt or ridicule;
15	(6) Falsely testify or provide information or withhold testimony or information with respect to another's
16	legal claim or defense; <del>or</del>
17	(7) Reproduce, distribute, exhibit, publish, transmit, or otherwise disseminate a visual depiction of any
18	person who is nude, or who is engaging in sexual conduct; or
19	(7) (8) Perform any other act which is calculated to harm another person materially with respect to the
20	other person's health, safety, business, calling, career, financial condition, reputation or personal relationships.

### **SYNOPSIS**

This Act expands the scope of the sexual extortion law to include: a) compelling or inducing another person to produce a visual depiction of the person or another who is nude or who is engaging in sexual conduct, and b) threatening to reproduce, distribute, exhibit, publish, transmit, or otherwise disseminate a visual depiction of a person who is nude, or who is engaging in sexual conduct.
