HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 95

RECOGNIZING THE YOUNG MEN FROM ACROSS THE STATE OF DELAWARE PARTICIPATING IN THE 2022
SESSION OF DELAWARE'S BOYS STATE.

54 program, as they have done for many years, thereby displaying a deep dedication to the American system of government
55 and to the essential task of ensuring that our youth understand and appreciate that system;
