SENATE AMENDMENT NO. 27 TO SENATE BILL NO. 320

1	AMEND Senate Bill No. 320 on line 37 after "chapter." by inserting the following therein:
2	"The application must require the elector to provide 1 of the following:
3	(1) The last 4 digits of the elector's social security number.
4	(2) The elector's State-issued driver's license number.
5	(3) The elector's State-issued nondriver identification card number.".
6	FURTHER AMEND Senate Bill No. 320 between line 78 and line 79 by inserting the following therein:
7	"(6) A designated space for the elector to provide 1 of the following:
8	a. The last 4 digits of elector's social security number.
9	b. The elector's State-issued driver's license number.
10	c. The elector's State-issued nondriver identification card number.".
11	FURTHER AMEND Senate Bill No. 320 on line 90 by deleting the word "oath." and inserting in lieu thereof the
12	following:
13	"oath and enter the elector's State-issued driver's license number or State-issued nondriver identification card, or
14	the last 4 digits of the elector's social security number.".
15	FURTHER AMEND Senate Bill No. 320 between line 198 and line 199 by inserting the following therein:
16	"(3) The ballot envelope does not contain the elector's State-issued driver's license number or State-issued
17	nondriver identification card, or the last 4 digits of the elector's social security number, as required under § 5608A(a)(2) of
18	this title.".

SYNOPSIS

This Amendment requires that an elector provide their State-issued driver's license number or State-issued nondriver identification card number or the last 4 digits of their social security number on the application to vote by mail ballot and on the ballot envelope.
