## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 70

RECOGNIZING JUNE 2023 AS "POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS INJURY MONTH" AND JUNE 27, 2023 AS "POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS INJURY DAY".

1 WHEREAS, Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder ("PTSD") is recognized by the American Psychiatric Association 2 psychiatric as a disorder that may occur in people who have experienced or witnessed a traumatic event such as a natural 3 disaster, a serious accident, a terrorist act, war/combat, violence, or injury; and 4 WHEREAS, historically, post-traumatic injuries have been unjustly portrayed as a mental illness caused by a 5 preexisting flaw of character or ability; and 6 WHEREAS, the word "disorder" carries a stigma that perpetuates this misconception which can discourage the 7 injured from seeking proper and timely medical treatment; and 8 WHEREAS, referring to the complications from post-traumatic stress as a disorder perpetuates the stigma of and 9 bias against mental illness; and 10 WHEREAS, electro-magnetic imaging has shown that PTSD is more accurately described as an injury; and 11 WHEREAS, severe post-traumatic stress is a very common, and treatable, injury to the brain which can occur following exposure to extremely traumatic events, such as assault or abuse, combat, serious accidents, and natural disasters; 12 13 and 14 WHEREAS, the term Post-Traumatic Stress Injury ("PTSI") is less stigmatizing and viewed as more honorable, 15 which can favorably influence people affected with the condition, encouraging them to seek treatment without fear of 16 retribution or shame; and 17 WHEREAS, the House of Representatives supports the preservation of all citizens' personal dignity; and 18 WHEREAS, all people suffering from PTSI deserve our compassion and consideration; and 19 WHEREAS, post-traumatic stress injuries disproportionately affect veterans and members of the United States 20 Armed Forces; and 21 WHEREAS, those brave men and women of the United States Armed Forces who have received these wounds in 22 action against an enemy of the United States deserve special tribute and acknowledgement; and 23 WHEREAS, PTSI is an injury that is repairable, and timely treatment can diminish complications and prevent 24 suicides among the injured. 25 NOW, THEREFORE:
