HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 14

WHEREAS, Harriet Ross Tubman was an American heroine and patriot who tirelessly worked to attain freedom

RECOGNIZING MARCH 10TH AS "HARRIET TUBMAN DAY".

3	WHEREAS, Harriet Ross Tubman was born into slavery in 1820 in Dorchester County, Maryland and escaped to
4	freedom in Canada before settling in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; and
5	WHEREAS, she was introduced to the Underground Railroad and became a conductor herself within one year
6	after her escape; and
7	WHEREAS, Harriet Tubman's trek included Delaware, since it was the last slave state on the Underground
8	Railroad's northern path, and
9	WHEREAS, Harriet Tubman helped lead hundreds of her people to freedom and was proud to claim she "never
10	ran her train off the track and never lost a passenger"; and
11	WHEREAS, Harriet Tubman passed on March 10, 1913, her last words to friends and family being "I go to
12	prepare a place for you"; and
13	WHEREAS, her last words further emphasize the life of strength, selflessness, and service she led in order help
14	others experience the beauty of freedom; and
15	WHEREAS, in 1990, March 10 was nationally declared as "Harriet Tubman Day" to commemorate the rich,
16	impactful legacy of Harriet Tubman.
