HOUSE BILL NO. 123

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 7 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

1           Section 1. Amend § 6010(a), Title 7 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and  
2 insertions as shown by underline as follows:

3           **§ 6010. Rules and regulations; plans.**

4           (a) The Secretary may adopt, amend, modify or repeal rules or regulations, or plans, after public hearing, to  
5 effectuate the policy and purposes of this chapter, excepting any such rules and regulations associated with Regulatory  
6 Initiatives that limit sales of any motor vehicles currently permitted under the advanced Clean Car I regulations, adopted in  
7 2014, without consent of the General Assembly, retroactive to March 1, 2023. No such rule or regulation shall extend,  
8 modify or conflict with any law of this State or the reasonable implications thereof.

**SYNOPSIS**

This act would require the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control to obtain the consent of the General Assembly before promulgating any regulations restricting the sale of fuel-powered cars, trucks, and SUVs in Delaware. This Act does not change the emission standards fuel-powered vehicles must currently meet. The provisions of this bill would be retroactive to March 1, 2023.
