HOUSE AMENDMENT NO. 1  
TO  
HOUSE BILL NO. 109

1 AMEND House Bill No. 109 by deleting lines 3 through 13 in their entirety and substituting in lieu thereof the  
2 following:

3 “§ 2712. Application for temporary instruction permits and Class D operator’s license for persons age 18 or older  
4 [Effective until April 1, 2025].

5 (a) A Class D temporary instruction permit may be issued to a person age 18 years or older. A temporary permit  
6 shall entitle the applicant to drive during a ~~6-month~~ 12-month period only when the applicant is accompanied by a  
7 licensed operator over the age of 21 who is actually occupying a seat beside the driver and there are no more than 2 other  
8 persons in the vehicle.

9 (b) If for any reason the applicant fails to pass the required examination during the ~~6-month~~ 12-month period  
10 granted by the permit, the permit shall be void, and the fee paid therefor shall be ~~forfeited unless the applicant requests an~~  
11 ~~extension thereof and pays the sum of \$5.00 therefor. Upon payment of the said sum, the Division shall immediately issue~~  
12 ~~only 1 extension of the permit for an additional 6 months. If the applicant fails to pass the required examination within the~~  
13 ~~additional 6-month period, the permit shall become void.~~ forfeited.

14 § 2712. Application for temporary instruction permits and Class D operator’s license for persons age 18 or older  
15 [Effective April 1, 2025].

16 (a) A Class D temporary instruction permit may be issued to a person age 18 years or older. A temporary permit  
17 shall entitle the applicant to drive during a ~~6-month~~ 12-month period only when the applicant is accompanied by a  
18 licensed operator over the age of 21 who is actually occupying a seat beside the driver and there are no more than 2 other  
19 persons in the vehicle.

20 (b) If for any reason the applicant fails to pass the required examination during the ~~6-month~~ 12-month period  
21 granted by the permit, the permit shall be void, and the fee paid therefor shall be ~~forfeited unless the applicant requests an~~  
22 ~~extension thereof and pays the sum of \$5.00 therefor. Upon payment of the said sum, the Division shall immediately issue~~

23 only 1 extension of the permit for an additional 6 months. If the applicant fails to pass the required examination within the  
24 additional 6-month period, the permit shall become void. forfeited.”.

#### SYNOPSIS

This amendment makes no changes to the content of House Bill No. 109, but because the Code currently contains 2 versions of this section to reflect a change in subsection (f) that is scheduled to occur on April 1, 2025, this amendment shows the changes in both versions to make it explicit that the changes are intended to carry through the pre and post-April 2025 versions of the section.
