SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 72

CONGRATULATING THE CLASS OF 2022 EAGLE SCOUTS FOR HAVING ATTAINED THE HIGHEST RANK
ONE CAN EARN IN THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA.

8 moves on to higher education, business or industry, and the world at large; and
