DELAWARE STATE SENATE 152nd GENERAL ASSEMBLY

SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 100

APPLICATION FOR A CONVENTION OF THE STATES UNDER ARTICLE V OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES.

1	WHEREAS, the Founders of our Constitution empowered State Legislators to be guardians of liberty against
2	future abuses of power by the federal government; and
3	WHEREAS, the federal government has created a crushing national debt through improper and imprudent
4	spending; and
5	WHEREAS, the federal government has invaded the legitimate roles of the states through the manipulative
6	process of federal mandates, most of which are unfunded to a great extent; and
7	WHEREAS, the federal government has ceased to live under a proper interpretation of the Constitution of the
8	United States; and
9	WHEREAS, it is the solemn duty of the States to protect the liberty of our people – particularly for the generations
10	to come - by proposing Amendments to the Constitution of the United States through a Convention of the States under
11	Article V for the purpose of restraining these and related abuses of power.
12	NOW, THEREFORE:
13	BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the 152 nd General Assembly of the State of Delaware, the House of
14	Representatives concurring therein, hereby applies to Congress, under the provisions of Article V of the Constitution of the
15	United States, for the calling of a convention of the states limited to proposing amendments to the Constitution of the
16	United States that impose fiscal restraints on the federal government, limit the power and jurisdiction of the federal
17	government, and limit the terms of office for its officials and for members of Congress.
18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is hereby directed to transmit copies of this
19	application to the President and Secretary of the United States Senate and to the Speaker and Clerk of the United States
20	House of Representatives, and copies to the members of the said Senate and House of Representatives from this State; also
21	to transmit copies hereof to the presiding officers of each of the legislative houses in the several States, requesting their
22	cooperation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this application constitutes a continuing application in accordance with Article V of the Constitution of the United States until the legislatures of at least two-thirds of the several states have made applications on the same subject.

SYNOPSIS

This resolution is an application for a Convention of the States under Article V of the Constitution of the United States.
