HOUSE BILL NO. 279

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 14 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO BEREAVEMENT LEAVE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

1           Section 1. Amend § 1318, Title 14 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and  
2     insertions as shown by underline as follows:

3           § 1318. Sick leave and absences for other reasons; accumulation of annual leave.

4           (j) Any absence not covered in subsection (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), ~~(f) or (g)~~ (f), or (l) of this section shall be  
5     considered unexcused.

6           (l) An employee is entitled to a maximum of 5 days of paid bereavement leave under the same circumstances set  
7     forth in § 5125 of Title 29.

SYNOPSIS

This Act allows school employees up to 5 days of bereavement leave under the same circumstances as permitted for state employees.
