SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 17

RECOGNIZING THE WORK OF THE WE ARE THE MOMS FOUNDATION TO BRING AWARENESS TO THE DEVASTATION CAUSED BY FIREARM VIOLENCE.

- 1           WHEREAS, firearm homicide and suicide deaths are at record high levels in the United States; and
- 2           WHEREAS, the most recent data from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention show that there were more
- 3 than 48,000 firearm-related deaths in the United States in 2022; and
- 4           WHEREAS, firearm injuries are the leading cause of death for children and teens between ages 1 and 19; and
- 5           WHEREAS, the mission of the We Are The Moms Foundation is to provide support, healing, and understanding
- 6 to mothers who have tragically lost their children to homicide, violence, or suicide; and
- 7           WHEREAS, the We Are the Moms Foundation strives to bring awareness to the tragedy of firearm violence and
- 8 the need for improved support systems for grieving mothers; and
- 9           WHEREAS, the members of the We Are The Moms Foundation seek to honor the memories of their children by
- 10 working toward a future where no mother has to endure the loss of a child to firearm violence.
- 11           NOW, THEREFORE:
- 12           BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the 152<sup>nd</sup> General Assembly of the State of Delaware that the Senate
- 13 recognizes the We Are The Moms Foundation for its dedication to raising awareness and supporting mothers who have lost
- 14 children to firearm violence.
