1 AMEND Senate Substitute No. 1 for Senate Bill No. 2 by deleting line 134 in its entirety and inserting in lieu
2 thereof the following:

3 "(n) (1) After a permit has been issued or a denial has become final, SBI may not retain any records relating to the
4 application or permit other than the name and date of birth of the applicant, the date the permit was issued or the denial
5 became final, and the date of the firearms training course completed by the applicant.

6 (2) Applications and any other information gathered under this section are not "public records" for purposes
7 of the Freedom of Information Act, Chapter 100 of Title 29."

8 FURTHER AMEND Senate Substitute No. 1 for Senate Bill No. 2 by deleting lines 182 through 191.

SYNOPSIS

This Amendment clarifies what information may be retained by SBI and explicitly exempts application and permit information from the Freedom of Information Act.
