HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 92

RECOGNIZING MARCH 14, 2024, AS “BE THE ONE DAY”.

1 WHEREAS, the American Legion has existed for more than 100 years to enhance the well-being of America’s
2 veterans and their families; and

3 WHEREAS, the number one issue facing those who served is veteran suicide; and

4 WHEREAS, in 2022, the American Legion launched its Be The One campaign to encourage American Legion
5 family members, veterans, servicemembers, and others to take action when they believe a veteran is at risk of suicide; and

6 WHEREAS, the American Legion is activating a national platform to end veteran suicide; and

7 WHEREAS, the Be The One campaign will destigmatize asking for mental health support, creating opportunity
8 for those with mental health issues to speak freely and get the support they need; and

9 WHEREAS, the stigma associated with mental health issues is a barrier to veterans seeking assistance; and

10 WHEREAS, the American Legion urges veterans and patriotic Americans to reach out to a veteran in order to Be
11 The One and save a life.

12 NOW, THEREFORE:

13 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring therein, that the General Assembly
14 hereby recognizes March 14, 2024, as “Be The One Day” and all citizens are encouraged to find a veteran in their
15 community they can support by letting them know you care.
