HOUSE AMENDMENT NO. 1
TO
HOUSE BILL NO. 15

1 AMEND House Bill No. 15 by deleting lines 38 through 42 in their entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the
2 following:

3 “risk for ovarian cancer. Such monitoring or screening tests shall be deemed a covered service, notwithstanding
4 any policy exclusions for services which are considered experimental or investigative; provided however, that nothing
5 contained herein shall be deemed to provide coverage for routine screening service. The terms of such coverage, including
6 cost-sharing requirements, shall be no less favorable than the terms of coverage, including cost-sharing requirements,
7 applicable to screening mammography for breast cancer.”.

8 FURTHER AMEND House Bill No. 15 by inserting the following after line 64 and before line 65:

9 "4. Breast cancer in a male relative."

10 FURTHER AMEND House Bill No. 15 by inserting the following after line 72 and before line 73:

11 "5. Polycystic ovarian syndrome."

12 FURTHER AMEND House Bill No. 15 by deleting lines 90 through 94 in their entirety and inserting in lieu
13 thereof the following:

14 “risk for ovarian cancer. Such monitoring or screening tests shall be deemed a covered service, notwithstanding
15 any policy exclusions for services which are considered experimental or investigative; provided however, that nothing
16 contained herein shall be deemed to provide coverage for routine screening service. The terms of such coverage, including
17 cost-sharing requirements, shall be no less favorable than the terms of coverage, including cost-sharing requirements,
18 applicable to screening mammography for breast cancer.”.

19 FURTHER AMEND House Bill No. 15 by inserting the following after line 111 and before line 112:

20 "4. Breast cancer in a male relative."

21 FURTHER AMEND House Bill No. 15 by inserting the following after line 119 and before line 120:

22 "5. Polycystic ovarian syndrome."

SYNOPSIS

This amendment adds having a family history of breast cancer in a male relative or a personal history of polycystic ovarian cancer to the definition of “at risk for ovarian cancer.” It also strikes references to experimental or investigative services.
