HOUSE BILL NO. 423

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 4 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO FARM WINERIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

1           Section 1. Amend § 512A, Title 4 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and  
2 insertions as shown by underline as follows:

3           § 512A. Farm wineries.

4           (j) A farm winery licensee shall be prohibited from owning or operating or being affiliated with any importer or  
5 retailer of alcoholic liquor either within or without this State. Notwithstanding the foregoing, it shall be permissible for a  
6 farm winery to apply to the Commissioner for a license, under § 512(g)(1) of this title, for use of a portion of the farm  
7 winery premises as a ~~eaterer~~ caterer, or to apply to the Commissioner for a license, under this title generally, for use of a  
8 portion of the farm winery premises as a restaurant.

SYNOPSIS

This Act permits a farm winery to apply for a license for use of a portion of the farm winery premises as a restaurant.
