SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 176

CONGRATULATING THE CLASS OF 2023 EAGLE SCOUTS FOR HAVING ATTAINED THE HIGHEST RANK ONE CAN EARN IN THE BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA.

1 WHEREAS, to earn the rank of Eagle Scout, a young person must earn Merit Badges in areas including First Aid,

6 preparedness, as well as advancing through the ranks of Scout, Tenderfoot, Second Class, First Class, Star, and Life; and

8 moves on to higher education, business or industry, and the world at large; and
