2	Howard University in Washington, D.C., and has been in relentless existence since January 15, 1908; and
3	WHEREAS, Ethel Hedgeman Lyle, Anna Easter Brown, Beulah Burke, Lillian Burke, Marjorie Hill, Margaret
4	Flagg Holmes, Lavinia Norman, Lucy Diggs Slowe and Marie Woolfolk Taylor, established the first Greek-lettered
5	organization established by and for African American, college-educated women; and
6	WHEREAS, Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated consists of 290,000 members globally, with record
7	breaking service community service to all mankind, totaling over one million hours, particularly in the African-American
8	neighborhoods; and
9	WHEREAS, Epsilon Iota Omega, Sigma Zeta Omega, Zeta Omega, Delta Lambda and Tau Omicron Chapters of
10	Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated's influence and civic contributions have brought about economic security,
11	environmental sustainability and addressed issues of global poverty, social justice and spiritual change throughout
12	Delaware, as well as nationally and internationally; and
13	WHEREAS, Epsilon Iota Omega, Sigma Zeta Omega, Zeta Omega, Delta Lambda and Tau Omicron Chapters of
14	Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated and its members have been actively involved in our local communities through
15	spearheading Emerging Young Leaders, AKAette and Debutante programs for middle and high school girls; partnering
16	with local restaurants to raise funds for Heifer International, sponsoring shoe drives for the needy; collaborating with local
17	churches to host Voter's Registration Drives; advocating health care initiatives; writing letters to support Anti-Bullying
18	laws; and many other community focused contributions; and
19	WHEREAS, for the fourteenth consecutive year the members of Delaware's Tri-Chapters of Alpha Kappa Alpha
20	Sorority, Incorporated, Zeta Omega Chapter, serving Wilmington and New Castle County Counties, Epsilon Iota Omega
21	Chapter, serving Kent County & Sussex County and Sigma Zeta Omega Chapter serving Newark, have provided consistent
