## HOUSE BILL NO. 365

## AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 4 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

- Section 1. Amend § 904(h), Title 4 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and insertions as shown by underline as follows:
- 3 § 904 Offenses concerning certain persons.
- 4 (h) Nothing in this section shall prevent the employment of a person 1918 years of age or older to serve alcoholic
- 5 liquor to patrons of establishments elubs with authorized dining facilities, hotels, racetracks and restaurants-licensed under
- 6 this title for the on-premises sale and consumption of alcoholic liquor, excepting taverns and taprooms.

#### **SYNOPSIS**

Currently, the age for wait staff to serve alcohol to a patron is 19 years old. This Act lowers the age of persons permitted to serve alcohol from 19 to 18 years of age for all establishments licensed for the on-premises sale and consumption of alcoholic liquor except taverns and taprooms.
