HOUSE BILL NO. 365

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 4 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

1 Section 1. Amend § 904(h), Title 4 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strike through and
2 insertions as shown by underline as follows:

3 § 904 Offenses concerning certain persons.

4 (h) Nothing in this section shall prevent the employment of a person ~~19~~18 years of age or older to serve alcoholic
5 liquor to patrons of establishments ~~clubs with authorized dining facilities, hotels, racetracks and restaurants~~ licensed under
6 this title for the on-premises sale and consumption of alcoholic liquor, excepting taverns and taprooms.

SYNOPSIS

Currently, the age for wait staff to serve alcohol to a patron is 19 years old. This Act lowers the age of persons permitted to serve alcohol from 19 to 18 years of age for all establishments licensed for the on-premises sale and consumption of alcoholic liquor except taverns and taprooms.
