## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 56

## DESIGNATING SEPTEMBER 1, 2018 AS "WESLEY COLLEGE DAY" IN DELAWARE 1 WHEREAS, Wesley College was founded on September 1, 1873; and 2 WHEREAS, Wesley College is Delaware's oldest private college; and 3 WHEREAS, Wesley College has been a treasured resource for Delaware throughout its almost 150 year history; 4 and 5 WHEREAS, Wesley College awards nearly \$42 million in financial aid and scholarships to students annually, 6 allowing students to pursue a higher education regardless of their financial background; and 7 WHEREAS, approximately 1,500 students attend the College's Dover campus each year from 21 states and 5 8 countries: and 9 WHEREAS, the College offers 30 bachelor's degrees, 4 associate's degrees, and master's degrees in nursing, 10 education, business administration and environmental science in a multi-denominational, multi-cultural campus setting; and 11 WHEREAS, consistent with its Methodist heritage, the College affirms meaning and purpose in life through 12 justice, compassion, inclusion and social responsibility that enhance community life and respect for the environment; and 13 WHEREAS, Wesley College exists to liberate and empower its students with the knowledge, skills, ethical 14 attitudes and capacity for critical thinking needed to achieve personal and professional goals and to contribute to the local 15 and global society. 16 NOW, THEREFORE: 17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the 149th General Assembly of the State of Delaware, the House concurring 18 therein, that September 1, 2018 be proclaimed as "Wesley College Day." 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitably prepared copy of this resolution be presented to Robert E. Clark II, 20 President of Wesley College. **SYNOPSIS**

This resolution designates September 1, 2018 as "Wesley College Day" in Delaware.
