SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 62

CELEBRATING TEACHER APPRECIATION WEEK.

1 WHEREAS, the State of Delaware employs more than 8,900 teachers; and

2 WHEREAS, teachers mold children through guidance and education; and

3 WHEREAS, teachers encounter students of widely differing backgrounds and who face a myriad of daily
4 challenges; and

5 WHEREAS, the future of the State of Delaware and the United States depends on providing quality education to
6 all students, regardless of background or challenges; and

7 WHEREAS, teachers spend untold hours and resources preparing lessons, evaluating progress, counseling and
8 coaching students, educating, and performing service to our community; and

9 WHEREAS, teachers work tirelessly to open children's minds to ideas, knowledge, and dreams; and

10 WHEREAS, teachers fill roles as listeners, explorers, role models, motivators, and mentors; and

11 WHEREAS, teachers continue to influence students long after school days are completed; and

12 WHEREAS, teachers are to be afforded high public esteem, reflecting the value our community places on public
13 education; and

14 WHEREAS, it is paramount that teachers be recognized for their dedication and commitment to educating our
15 students.

16 NOW, THEREFORE:

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the 149th General Assembly of the State of Delaware, the House of
18 Representatives concurring therein, recognizes May 7-11, 2018 as National Teacher Appreciation Week;

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Senate expresses its gratitude for the indefatigable and untiring efforts
20 and actions of Delaware teachers in educating approximately 137,000 Delaware students.
