| 0 | resources to pay for treatment, including clinical and related services for an individual with a mental health condition or |

| 12 | FURTHER AMEND Senate Bill No. 32 on line 87 by inserting "(a)" before "The" therein. |
| 13 | FURTHER AMEND Senate Bill No. 32 between lines 88 and 89 by inserting the following: |
| 14 | "(b) A violation of this chapter shall be deemed an unlawful practice under § 2513 of this title and a violation of |
| 15 | Subchapter II of Chapter 25 of this title. |
| 16 | (c) Nothing in this chapter modifies requirements under mental health parity laws, including § 3343, § 3571T, or § |
| 17 | 3578 of Title 18 or the federal Mental Health Parity and Addiction Equity Act of 2008 (29 U.S.C. § 1185a).". |

SYNOPSIS

This Amendment makes the following changes to Senate Bill No. 32:

- 1. Identifies additional kinds of payments that are not prohibited.
- 2. Uses enforcement language that is consistent with other chapters in Title 6.
- 3. Clarifies that this Act does not modify any requirements under State or federal mental health parity laws.
