HOUSE BILL NO. 138

AN ACT TO AMEND TITLE 4 OF THE DELAWARE CODE RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF DELAWARE:

1           Section 1. Amend § 546, Title 4 of the Delaware Code by making deletions as shown by strikethrough and  
2     insertions as shown by underline as follows:

3           § 546. Limit on number of retail licenses.

4           (b) The Commissioner shall refuse to grant a license for the sale of alcoholic liquor by any restaurant, taproom,  
5     hotel, store or other establishment for consumption off the premises where sold if the Commissioner has substantial  
6     evidence that would reasonably support a belief that the applicant, or any of the applicant's directors, officers or  
7     shareholders, or any of the applicant's partners, corporations, proprietorships or other legal entities engaged in any  
8     undertaking, industry or business is singularly, or in combination with the applicant, the holder of 2~~3~~ or more retail  
9     licenses, or has any financial, pecuniary, beneficial, management, supervisory or other interest whatsoever, direct or  
10    indirect, and however small, in 2~~3~~ or more retail licenses; provided, however, that nothing herein shall require any person  
11    who, prior to April 1, 1992, acquired an interest in more than 2~~3~~ retail licenses to surrender, dispose of, or release their  
12    interest in any such license; nor shall anything herein affect such person's right to continue to hold, use and renew any such  
13    license.

SYNOPSIS

      This Act increases by one the number of licenses for the sale of alcoholic liquor an individual or entity may have  
an interest in, from two to three.
