## HOUSE AMENDMENT NO. 4 TO SENATE BILL NO. 139

1	AMEND Senate Bill No. 139 on line 28 by adding "primarily" after "constructed" and before "of" as they appear
2	therein.
3	FURTHER AMEND Senate Bill No. 139 on line 42 by adding "only" after "having" and before "wire".
4	FURTHER AMEND Senate Bill No. 139 by deleting line 76 in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the
5	following:
6	2. Dogs within a designated "off-leash" dog park or area, or within an area permitted by a
7	governmental entity including a municipality, and attended by the dog's owner or custodian.

## **SYNOPSIS**

This amendment clarifies that dog houses cannot be constructed entirely of metal. This amendment also clarifies that a dog may not be sheltered inan enclosure having only wire flooring. This amendment also clarifies that dogs may be without a leash, but under reasonable control of a competent person, obedient to the person's command, and attended by the dog's owner or custodian in an area permitted by a governmental entity including a municipality.
